

SPECIAL COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
December 21, 2022
TO SET THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS FOR 2024-2027

A special meeting of the Monroe County Board of Commissioners was held on Wednesday, December 21, 2022, in the Commissioners' Public Meeting Room at the Monroe County Administrative Center with the following present: Chairman Sharon S. Laverdure, Vice-Chairman John R. Moyer, Commissioner John D. Christy, and Chief Clerk/Administrator Greg Christine.

Chairman Laverdure called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with a moment of silence and the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

There was no public comment.

Chairman Laverdure stated the purpose of the meeting was to set salaries for specific elected officials for 2024-2027 per the state statute.

R-2022-13 Motion by Vice-Chairman Moyer, seconded by Commissioner Christy and carried to adopt a Resolution setting salaries for Commissioners, Controller, Prothonotary/Clerk of Courts, Recorder of Deeds/Register of Wills and Sheriff for 2024 through 2027, as follows:

2024 - 2.5% over the previous year's salary
2025 - 2.5% over the previous year's salary
2026 - 2.5% over the previous year's salary
2027 - 2.5% over the previous year's salary

Commissioner Moyer stated that the amount of elected official salaries should be under what the Commissioners give to their employees, which has historically been, three (3) percent per year.

The meeting adjourned at 6:09 p.m.
