Notice is hereby given that nominations will be made at the Municipal Primary Election to be held Tuesday, May 16, 2023, in and for Monroe County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Each Political Party is entitled to nominate candidates for the following offices:

One person for Justice of the Supreme Court.

Two persons for Judge of the Superior Court.

One person for the Judge of the Commonwealth Court

Two persons for the office of County Commissioner.

One person for the office of County Controller.

One person for the office of District Attorney.

One person for the Office of Prothonotary and Clerk of Courts.

One person for the Office of Register of Wills and Recorder of Deeds.

One person for the office of Sheriff.

One person for the office of District Justice, Magisterial Districts, 43-2-02, 43-3-01, 43-3-03, 43-3-04, 43-4-01, and 43-4-04

Each political party is entitled to nominate candidates for the following Borough, Township and Ward offices if the incumbent's term shall expire on the first Monday of January 2024.

Mayor, Councilperson, Supervisors, Auditors, Constables, Tax Collector, School Directors in the various School Districts.
