Medical Transportation

Driving county residents to essential medical appointments

Minor Home Repair

Making minor repairs around seniors' houses with an emphasis on safety, including grab bars, step and railing repair, minor electrical and plumbing work

Friendly Visitor/Phone Call/Notes of Cheer

Providing socialization to isolated seniors with in-person visits, phone calls, or handwritten letters and cards

Veteran and Military Family Programs

Connecting Veterans and Military families with benefits and resources

School Programs

Teaching, tutoring, or mentoring students of all ages, from preschool to college, through our intergenerational programs, helping in classrooms, interactive storytelling or group reading

Clerical/Office Help

Making calls and answering phones, entering data, and bulk mailing
